Q1. Attempt Any ONE Out of the Following:

1 **Map Mandala – “Earth’s Lines in Art”**

Create a mandala using only circles (latitudes) and straight lines (longitudes). Colour each ring differently and label the major latitudes.

2 **Latitude–Longitude Puzzle Wheel**

Create a two-layer rotating wheel. The top layer should contain windows and the bottom layer should contain coordinates. When rotated, each window should reveal a place name or picture.

3 **Thread Art – “Web of Longitudes”**

Use a cardboard circle. Hammer small pins around the edge and use coloured thread to create longitude lines. Add a horizontal thread for the Equator.
